



Thank you for your purchase. Your choice will save you time, money, and will help you do your part in saving our environment.

Directions for Use:

Simply add the concentrated dry powder contents of this package to water at a ratio of 20g (4.5L pack) to 1 Imp gallon or 100g (22L pack) to 5 Imp gallons of water, and stir thoroughly. Some particles may not dissolve completely. This is normal. It will not reduce the efficacy of the product. Stir occasionally during use to maintain proper solution. Use only a sealable plastic container if storing solution. If using a sprayer, mix and let sit for 5 to 10 minutes. Stir well and screen before putting product into sprayer.

Apply to bare, untreated or pressure treated wood. Apply solution with a brush, roller, sprayer, or by dipping. If using a sprayer, be sure to strain the solution before pouring into sprayer. Ensure that all wood surfaces have been completely saturated by the product, especially end grains, fresh cuts, and open cracks. Some types of wood surfaces will show no immediate visible change in colour. This is completely normal. After exposure to sun and rain, the treatment will react with the wood. Gradually changing colour, the wood will eventually rest between an olive brown and velvety silver, depending on the type of wood and degree of exposure to the elements.

Precautions:

LIFETIME[®] treated wood is not toxic and safe for people, animals, soil, plants and water. The dry powder concentrate is acidic. Avoid inhalation and contact with eyes. In case of accidental contact with eyes, flush with water for a minimum of 15 minutes. If irritation persists, seek medical attention. Ingestion of solution may cause gastrointestinal irritation. Use care in applying solution as it may permanently stain fabrics, glass, vinyl, stucco, concrete, stone work, and chinking. Do not use with fire retardant treated wood. Do not clean LIFETIME[®] treated wood with anything other than water and simple soap (if necessary). Be aware that urine and bird feces will significantly discolour LIFETIME[®] treated wood.

Therefore, the availability of this non-toxic, eco-friendly product is truly, good news for all. Users of LIFE TIME® WOOD TREATMENT will benefit greatly through savings in time and money, while lessening the harmful impact on our soil, air, water, and forests. Let's do our part.

Following are some frequently asked questions about LIFE TIME® WOOD TREATMENT, with some straight answers from the manufacturer, Valhalla Wood Preservatives Ltd.:

Q: *What is LIFE TIME® WOOD TREATMENT?*

A: LIFE TIME® is a highly effective non-toxic wood treatment which beautifies and significantly extends the life of outdoor and indoor wood. No wood lasts forever but, versus untreated, LIFE TIME® treated wood will extend the life of the wood by at least double.

Q: *Many products claim to be safe to use. What makes LIFE TIME® so different?*

A: LIFE TIME® is composed of non-toxic ingredients. It also works with the sun's rays instead of protecting against them. UV rays help mature and set our product.

Q: *What is LIFE TIME® made of?*

A: LIFE TIME® is made up of naturally occurring plant and mineral substances, combined in a special family recipe. The solution soaks in to penetrate and harden wood fibres. Independent laboratory testing confirms that LIFE TIME® creates no harmful residue in soil or water.

Q: *Lots of products for exterior wood claim to be low maintenance, but in fact have to be re-applied within 2-3 years. What does LIFE TIME® mean by no maintenance?*

A: No maintenance means you apply LIFE TIME® once and never have to re-apply. LIFE TIME® will not wear off. It will not peel or fade as natural weathering actually increases its beauty and effectiveness.

Q: *Is LIFE TIME® usable on most types of wood?*

A: Absolutely. LIFE TIME® can be used on any wood species. It is suitable for most, if not all, applications like: decks, fences, siding, flower pots, picnic tables, furniture, raised planters, birdhouses, siding, doors, windows, gazebos, playgrounds, beehives, and even floating rafts and marina docks.

Q: *How is LIFE TIME® applied?*

A: It can be applied in all conventional ways including by brush, roller, sprayer, and dipping. It can be safely worked with while still wet without leaving permanent finger or foot marks. It can also be applied in any weather, except for heavy rain and freezing conditions.

Q: *How long is its shelf life?*

A: In powder or liquid form, LIFE TIME® can be stored indefinitely. After mixing with water, keep the solution in a sealed plastic container, in a cool, dark location. In time, the water may become stagnant unless distilled water is used to mix the batch. This stagnation will not hinder LIFE TIME®'s effectiveness. Due to the fact that you can mix only what you need, the likelihood that large amounts of LIFE TIME® solution will be left over is minimized.

Q: *Will LIFE TIME® prevent wood from cracking and warping?*

A: All wood contains moisture and dries during exposure to sun and wind. LIFE TIME® will not cause additional cracking or checking in the wood, but the wood will behave the same as if it were untreated.

- Q: *It sounds expensive. Is it?*
A: No. Considering the fact that you need only apply it once, it will be your cheapest option. In fact, LIFE TIME® is priced below several nationally advertised stains and wood treatments that must be applied many times over the life of the wood. LIFE TIME® is simply the least expensive and most effective wood treatment available.
- Q: *Can I apply sealers or coloured stains over LIFE TIME®?*
A: Yes you can, but we don't recommend it as it is not necessary from a preservation standpoint. Always test for an adverse reaction before applying over our product.
- Q: *Who is using LIFE TIME® WOOD TREATMENT?*
A: Contractors have been using it for over 60 years in house and marina construction. Parks Canada has been using LIFE TIME® for more than 20 years, treating outdoor wood in several of our National Parks, including Banff, Kootenay, and Yoho. The British Columbia Ministry of Transportation approves LIFE TIME® for municipal and highway signage projects, the City of Calgary is using LIFE TIME® for treating wooden roadside sound barrier fencing, and Nova Scotia Natural Resources is testing the product on picnic tables in provincial parks. Many construction contractors and log home builders are using the product in Canada, the United States, and internationally.

Helpful hints for LIFE TIME® Users...

- 1) While constructing an outdoor project, keep a bucket of LIFE TIME® solution handy. Use of a deep pail allows dipping of board ends, fresh cuts, etc.
- 2) For larger projects, set up a dipping tank on the ground that is large enough to completely immerse the wood in the solution. Allow the wood to sit in the solution for a few minutes. Posts and other wood to be in direct contact with soil should soak for approximately 12 hours.
- 3) LIFE TIME® solution never gets tacky or sticky. You may work with the treated wood while still wet. Handling of freshly treated wood or walking on wet decking will not permanently mark the wood, except if you sticker it right away.
- 4) For faster weathering and accelerated colour change, simply allow to dry completely (1-2 days) under normal conditions, then wet down with water. The more often the wood is exposed to water and sun, the faster the mature silver-to-dark-brown colour will develop.
- 5) Cleanup is easy using warm soapy water for brushes, rollers, sprayers and hands. No solvents or thinners are required.
- 6) Keep your projects clean from dirt and organic accumulations, in order to prolong the life of your wood, by effective cleaning at least once a year. Use only soap and water with a strong bristled brush, or power washer.

Note: The use of oil based and latex products in combination with LIFE TIME® WOOD TREATMENT may diminish the effectiveness of this product. LIFE TIME® treated wood requires no other sealers or treatments of any kind. One application will last for the LIFE TIME® of the wood. Use care in applying solution as it may permanently stain fabrics, glass, vinyl, stucco, concrete, stone work, and chinking. Do not use with fire retardant treated wood. Do not clean LIFE TIME® treated wood with anything other than water and simple soap (if necessary). Be aware that urine and bird feces will significantly discolour LIFE TIME® treated wood.
